Please note, course renewal does not change a course's review rating of either "contingent" or "full" approval. Full approval is granted after an on-site review by a Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity (LEO) representative and the course is found to meet LEO full approval criteria.

Training sponsors are advised that Act 440, as amended, requires training sponsors to submit the following:

1. Notice of scheduled courses not less than 7 calendar days before the start of those courses, indicating starting and ending dates and times, location, and instructors. LEO must also be advised of course cancellations no less than 1 day before the indicated start date.
2. Within 10 calendar days after issuing certificates of successful course completion, a list of all persons who successfully completed each training course, passed the examination, and were issued certificates must be submitted to LEO. This list must include the person's full name, social security number, address, course name and course completion date.
3. LEO must be notified prior to any substitutions or additions of the original course curriculum, course materials, course instructors, or course examination. LEO may revoke or suspend approval of your training course if alterations in the course cause it to fail to meet the requirements of Act 440 of the Public Acts of 1988, as amended. These alterations might include a change in the course length, changes in the course content, or use of instructors other than those indicated in the original application. Training course sponsors must notify this office of any changes in training course staff or faculty. Please submit resumes of any new instructors before substitutions or additions are made.

In addition to those above requirements, each course sponsor is required to:

1. Verify that each student attending a refresher course has satisfactorily completed the initial training course.
2. Provide each student who satisfactorily completes each course with a course certificate. Please be advised, this certificate is the property of the student, not the student's employer.
3. Supply each student who successfully passes your course with a "Michigan Asbestos Abatement Accreditation Application." The completed application must be submitted with the appropriate remittance to LEO before an individual can begin asbestos-related work in the State of Michigan.
4. Maintain all required records as mandated in Part 763 of Title 40 the Environmental Protection Agency Asbestos Model Accreditation Plan for a minimum of 3 years.
